

**PVRC Residents Meeting  
Meeting Minutes  
Jan 22, 2008  
Palo Verde Clubhouse**

**Proceedings**

Meeting called to order at 7:10pm by Chair John Pyles. PVRC members respond to resident concerns:

Visitor parking availability

- Residents are concerned about the lack of visitor-designated spaces around the community, and the limited number of permits provided to residents.
- John updates residents on the new electronic license plate recognition (LPR) system that will be implemented this July. This system will allow residents to log in visitor vehicle information online, such that Parking and Transportation officials will no longer need paper permits on visitor vehicles. This will not affect the number of visitor-designated spaces, but will increase the number of visitors allowed to each resident per day.

Palo Verde as a study-friendly environment

- One resident is concerned that the conference room is not open when the lounge is, and that conference room keys are not given out with lounge keys. This is unfortunate, because the conference room is a useful study space. The resident also asks if a printer can be provided in the computer lab in the lounge.
- PVRC members agree to follow up with key availability and the hours the conference room is locked. The facility should be available for student use.
- PVRC members agree to provide a printer for PV residents. This will come out of PVRC funds.

Events for PV residents

- One resident asks why there aren't more social events in the community, for residents.
- PVRC members and residents discuss possibilities for the next PVRC-sponsored event. Possibilities include a super bowl party, a bowling night, karaoke night, party at the pub, "speed-dating", or trips to local amusement parks.
